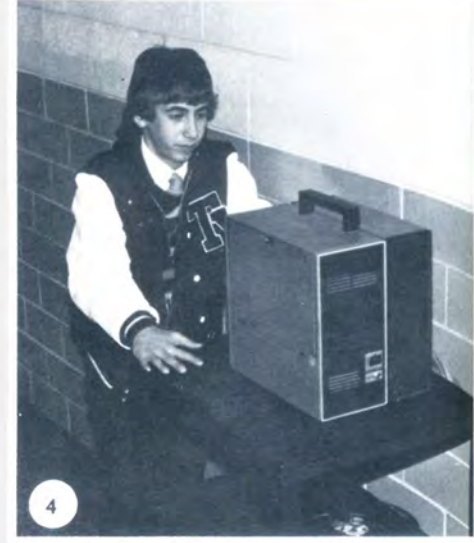

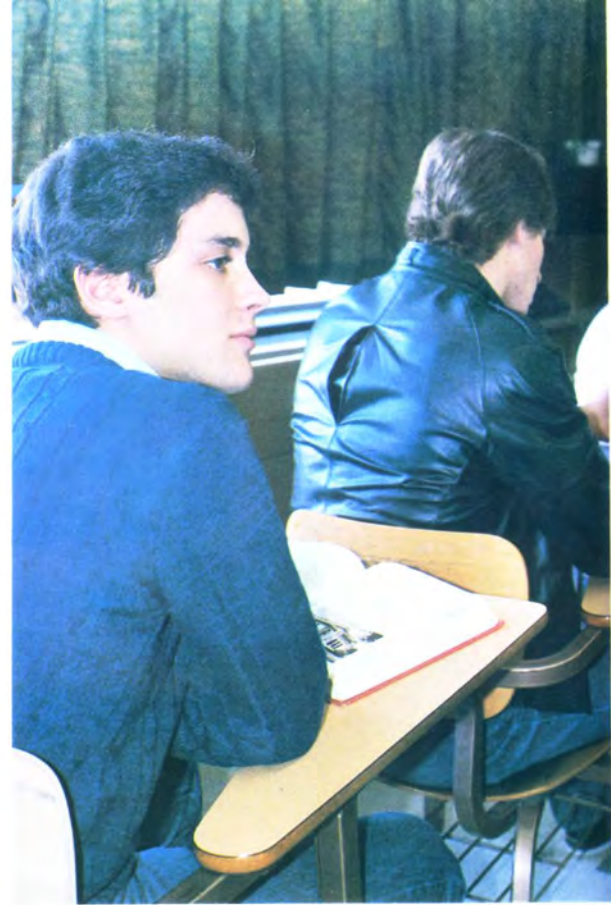

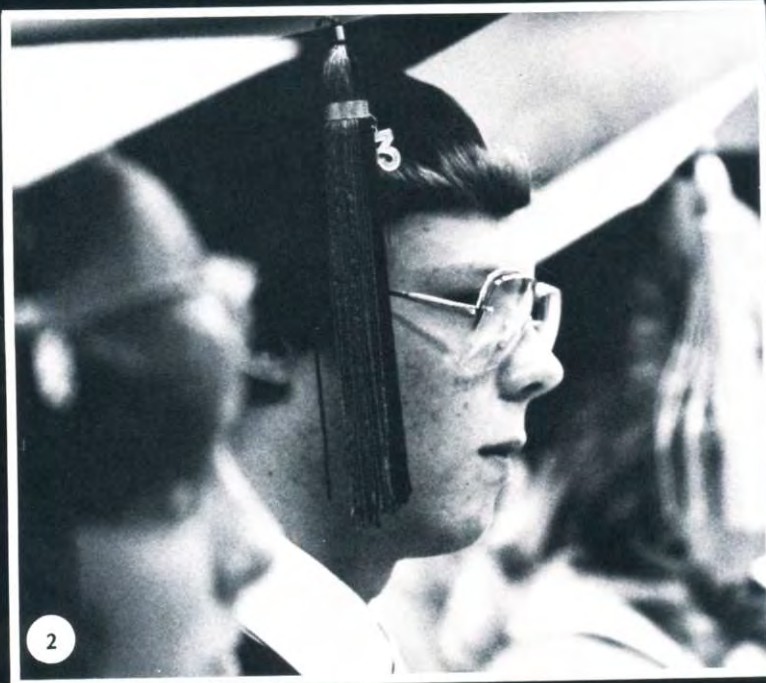

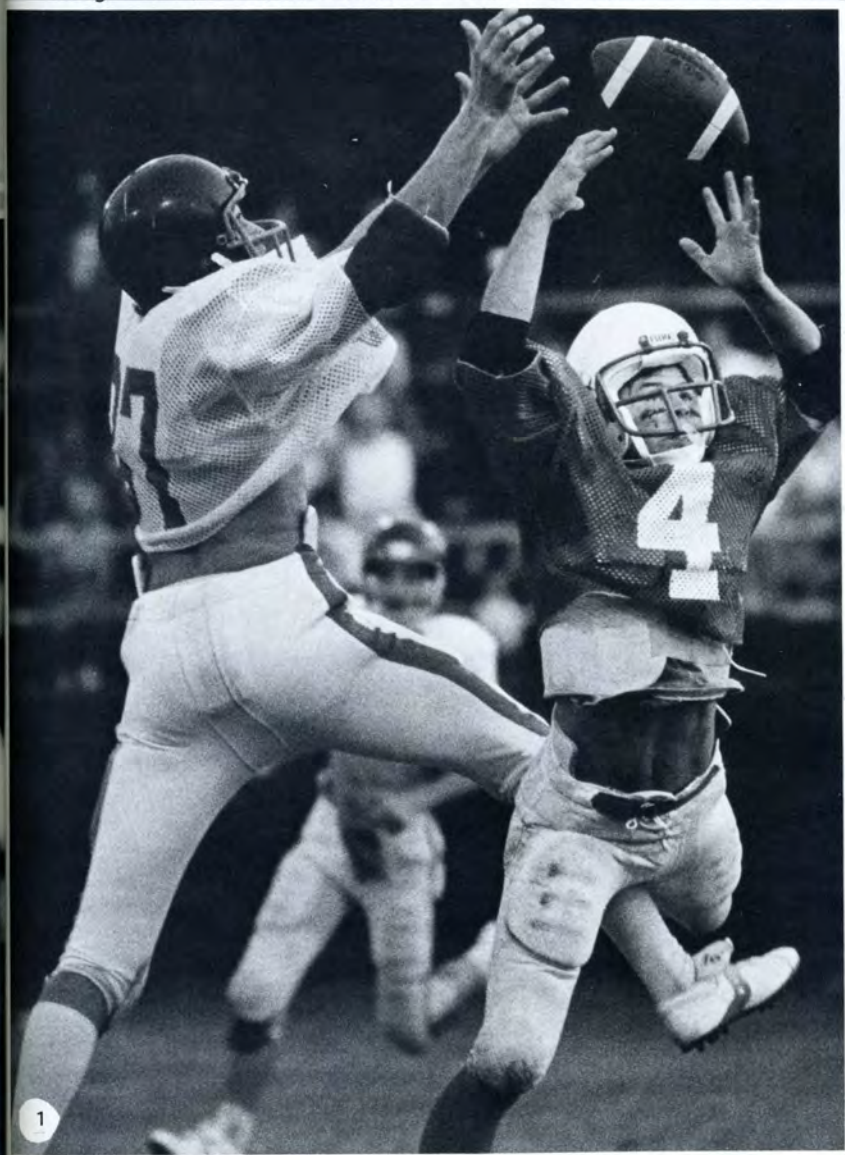

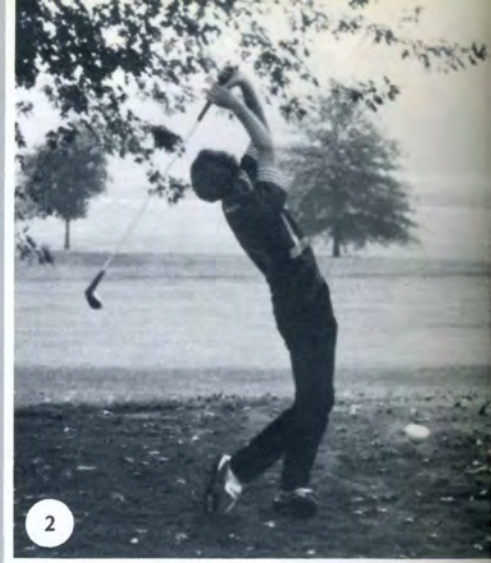

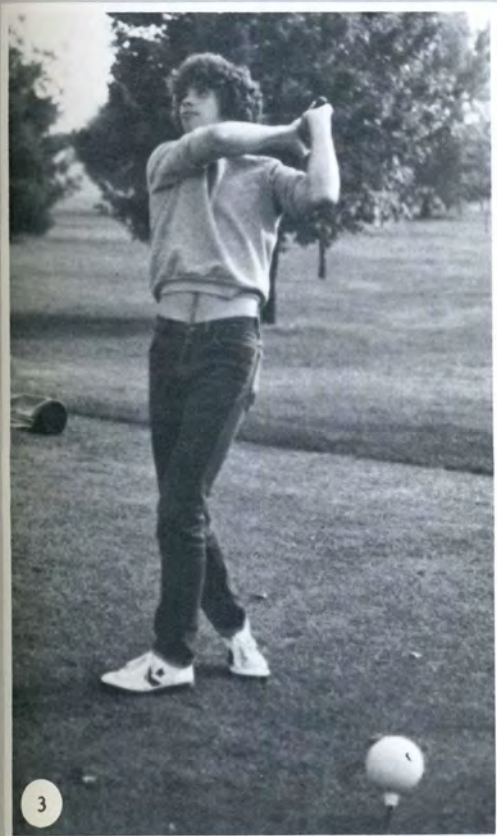

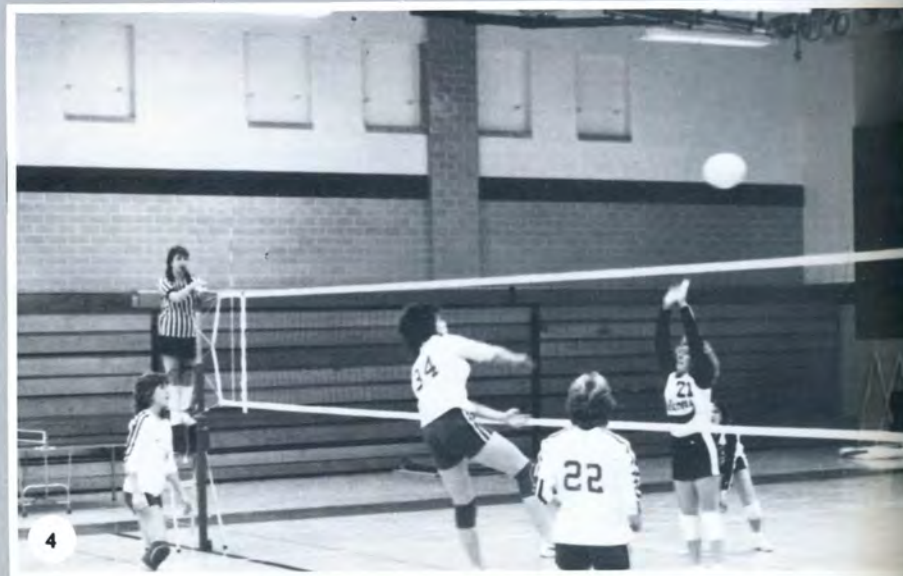


7 Volleyball Lettermen to Return in '83

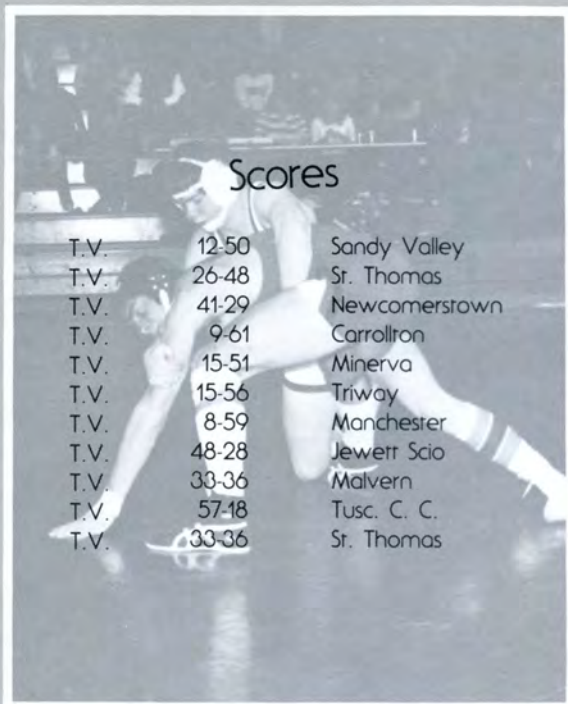


Wrestling Future Bright With 10 Frosh

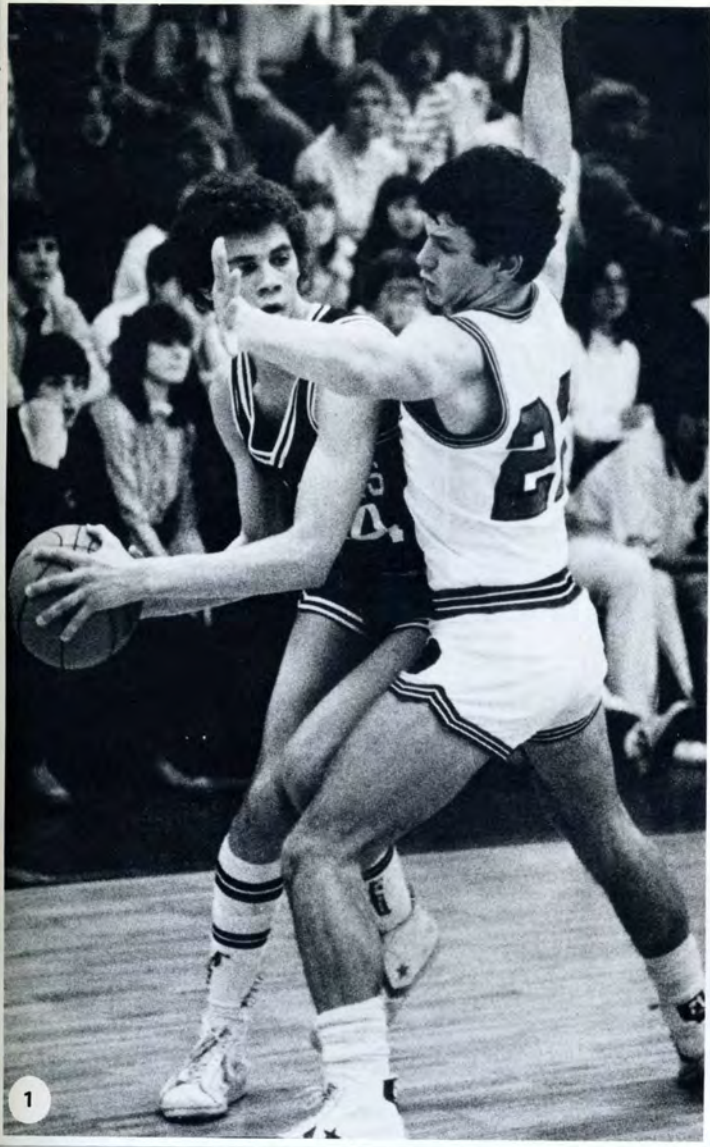

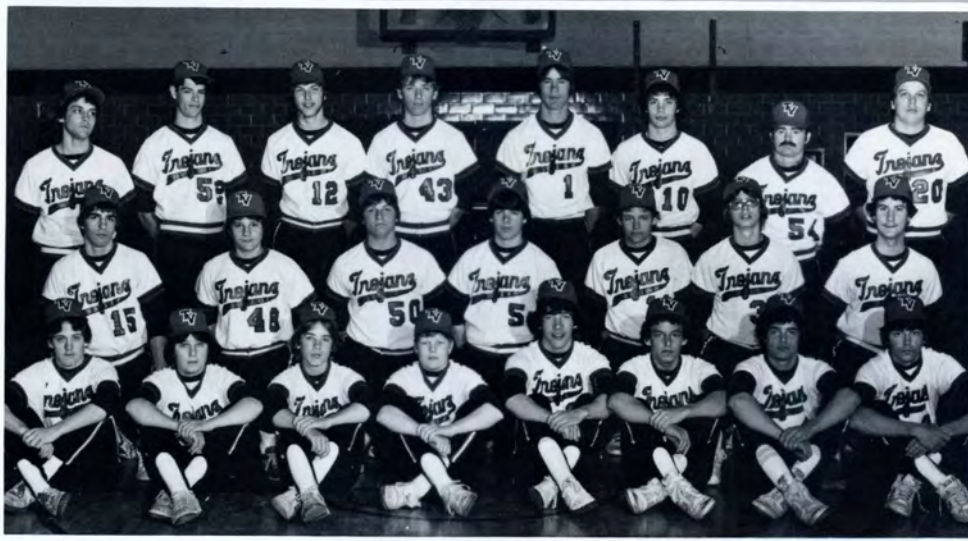

Wet spring weather turned out to be a strong opponent for the baseball team as rain-outs and rescheduled games allowed only seventeen of the twenty-six scheduled games to be played. The foul weather brought the season to an abrupt end with a 3-14 Tusky Valley season record including a narrow loss, 9-10, to Canton Central Catholic in an exciting extra inning game. The season victories were especially rewarding as they came against long-standing rivals West Holmes (14-2), Manchester (4-0), and Fairless where three seventh inning runs brought T. V. out on top 9-8. The team was led by four-year lettermen Craig Cantrill, Ron Franks, and Bob Shonk. Craig Cantrill's 2.76 earned run average earned him the team's best pitcher award. Highest batting average recognition went to Greg Williamson (.424) and Scott Coates (.407), while Bob Shonk had the most runs batted in with fourteen. Scott Coates was named to the first team All-A.O.C. and to the first team Eastern District. Bob Shonk received honorable mention in the A.O.C. and in the Eastern District.

Track: Boys 1st., Girls 2nd. in A.O.C.

The track team came out on top for the second year in a row. With 1983 being Tusky Valley's last year in the All Ohio Conference league, both teams left their mark. The girls team took the second place award while the boys captured the first place title in the A.O.C. Conference champions for the girls were Andrea Beans in the long jump and Mia Miller in the high jump. First place for the boys went to Toby Oswald in the pole vault and Mike Westendorf in the low hurdles. There were nine second place winners for the boys and thirteen second place winners for the girls. The girls team finished their season 7-1 winning the Dover Relays and the Newcomerstown tournament and capturing the district championship. The boys finished 8-0 with an undefeated season in dual meets winning the A.O.C. title and taking second place in the Dover Relays and in the Claymont invitational and coming out in second place at districts. The boys also ended fourth at regional competition and tenth at Shadyside. Eight Tusky Valley track team members went on to represent the school in state competition.

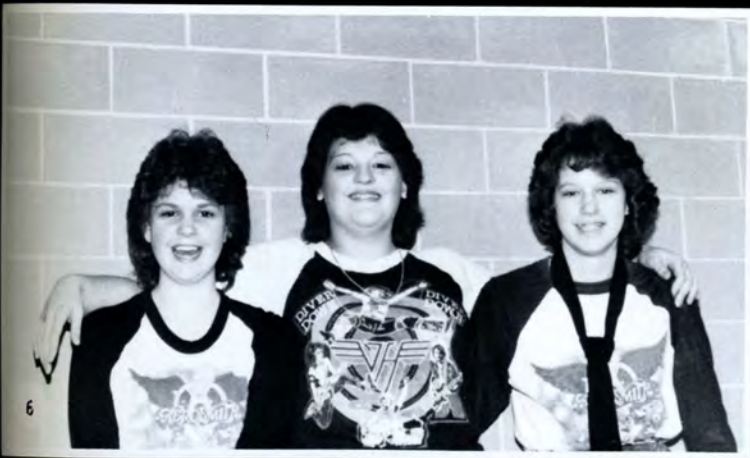

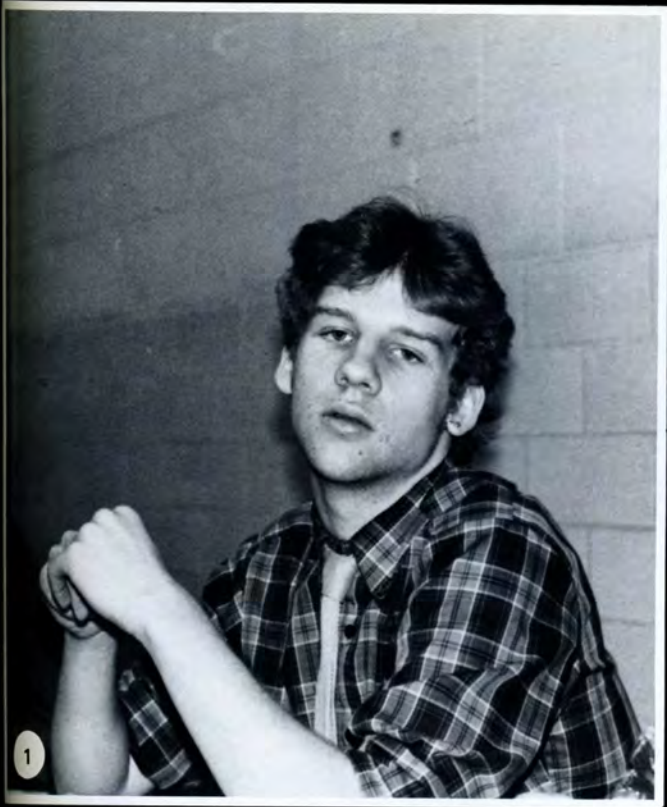
Angela Visits The U.S.A. And T.V.H.S.



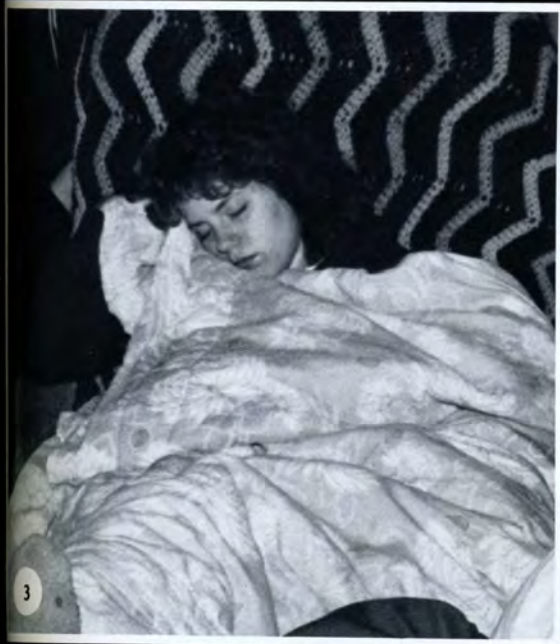
