Each year school districts throughout the state of Ohio participate in an effort to locate, evaluate, and identify all children with disabilities birth through age twenty-one. A disability is a condition such as:

- autism
- deaf-blindness
- deafness
- emotional disturbance
- hearing impairment
- intellectual disability
- multiple disabilities
- orthopedic impairment
- other health impairment
- specific learning disability
- speech or language impairment
- traumatic brain injury
- visual impairment (including blindness)

Parents may not be aware that there are programs and services available for these children.
